First Reading [Exodus 22:20-26] The faithful and gracious Lord said "You shall not wrong any widow or orphan...If you take your neighbor's cloak...return it before sunset. If he cries out to me, I will hear him; for I am compassionate."

Second Reading [1 Thessalonians 1:1-5c-10] Paul commended the Christians of Thessalonica: You became imitators of us and of the Lord, receiving the word in great affliction, with the joy from the Holy Spirit. So that you became a model for all believers...the word of the Lord has sounded forth."

Gospel [Matthew 22:34-40] In response to a question from some Pharisees who wanted to trip him up, Jesus said, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart...soul...and mind. You shall love your neighbor as yourself." These are two great commandments.
